# SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Exhibition is held under the Rules of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy and is open to all. Copies of the Rules are available from the GCCF 5 Kings Castle Business Park, The Drove, Bridgewater, Somerset TA6 4AG, or from the Show Manager, price £2.50 See also [www.gccfcats.org](http://www.gccfcats.org)  
**WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND THAT YOU OBTAIN THESE RULES AND READ SECTION 4 'EVASION OR BREACH OF ANY OF THE GCCF RULES MAY LEAD TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION'.**
2. Cats will be received at the entrance to the Show Hall on Saturday, 2nd December 2017, from 8.00am to 9.45am
3. Each exhibit **MUST** be examined by the Clubs Hon. Veterinary Surgeons before being penned. Any exhibit found to be unfit will not be allowed to compete and the entry fee will be forfeited. If, in the opinion of the Veterinary Officer, it is necessary, all other exhibits from the same cattery and the owner shall be debarred from attending the Show. Please ensure that your cats ears are clean and free from ear mites, its coat is free from fleas and it shows no sign of any infectious disease. The officiating Veterinary Surgeons have authority to exclude any cats showing skin lesions and, if necessary, all in contact cats. Any cat found to be suffering from the effects of drugs on entry or at any time during the Show will be subject to expulsion from the Show on the authority of the Veterinary Surgeon. The decisions of the Veterinary Surgeon are final.  
**THE OWNER OF ANY EXHIBIT REJECTED BY THE VETERINARY SURGEON SHOULD NOT LEAVE THE HALL WITHOUT FIRST OBTAINING THE APPROPRIATE CERTIFICATE FROM THE SHOW MANAGER. FAILURE TO DO SO WILL DELAY THEIR CLEARANCE TO EXHIBIT AT SUBSEQUENT SHOWS.**
4. All exhibits must be accompanied by their owner or representative and must be transported in a suitable container. **CARRIER BASKETS THAT ARE TOP-OPENING ARE TO BE PREFERRED.** The owner or representative must be within call at all times
5. Exhibitors are responsible for the correct description of their cats and for entering them in the correct classes. **FILL YOUR CATS DETAILS ON TO YOUR ENTRY FORM FROM THE GCCF REGISTRATION DOCUMENT TO ENSURE ACCURACY, NOT FROM THE CATS PEDIGREE.**  
Entry forms must be signed by the REGISTERED owner/owners of the exhibit and forwarded to the Show Manager accompanied by the correct entry fee.  
Note – 'N.A.F' (Name Applied For), is no longer accepted on entry forms. Name of first choice should be given.
6. **EXHIBITORS MUST PROVIDE PLAIN WHITE LITTER TRAYS, WHITE DRINKING BOWLS AND FOOD DISHES, AND WHITE BLANKETS WITHOUT DISTINGUISHING MARKS.** Blankets must be absolutely plain; cellular, embroidered or edged blankets or polystyrene-filled cushions may result in disqualification: Vet-bed or like material with white or green backing may be used. If in doubt, consult the Show Manager before the cat is penned. A hot water bottle or heat reflecting material may be used provided it is concealed. Water should be left in the water dish but nothing else should be left in the pen when judging starts. Printed Standard of Points should be placed by exhibitors on the cat's pens for Preliminary Breeds exhibits only. No other printed matter at all is permitted.
7. **SPRAYS OF ANY KIND ARE FORBIDDEN. EXHIBITORS SHOULD TAKE GREAT CARE NOT TO USE ANY SHAMPOO OR PREPARATION THAT MAY IN ANY WAY ALTER THE COLOUR OR APPEARANCE OF THEIR CAT. THEIR USE WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION ANY MAY LEAD TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION.**
8. VETTING IN SLIPS will be handed out on the morning of the Show.
9. The Committee reserve the right to:-
  - (a) Cancel, split or amalgamate classes.
  - (b) Refuse entry without giving a reason.
  - (c) Appoint other judges should any of the judges appointed be unable to fulfil their engagement.  
An announcement on the GCCF Website of any alterations or additions made to the Schedule shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof. A notice will also be displayed in the Show Hall.
  - (d) Retain a percentage of entry fees should the Show have to be cancelled for any reason.
10. If an exhibit cannot be shown due to illness, 50% of the entry fee will be refunded, provided a veterinary certificate is received by the Show Manager no less than 14 days prior to the show.
11. Exhibits are only received on the condition that the Club shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage to cats, baskets or boxes or in any other way. Whilst the committee will do all in their power to prevent improper removal of any cat or kitten, exhibitors are reminded they are solely responsible for the safety of their exhibits.  
Exhibitors will accept liability for any Veterinary or other expense incurred on their behalf by the Show Management in their absence from the Show Hall.
12. Exhibitors and visitors are strictly forbidden to remove from its pen any exhibit (including their own), without the permission of the Show Manager.
13. Photographs may only be taken in the Show Hall with the permission of the Show Manager and, if relevant, of the owner of the exhibit.
14. All pedigree exhibits must be registered with the GCCF and where ownership has changed since the original registration, the GCCF offices must have received the request for transfer form at least 21 days prior to the Show.
15. An exhibitor may not enter a cat in two shows taking place within 13 days, whether or not such a cat is actually present at either show.
16. Queens who are pregnant, lactating or who have kitted within the past twelve weeks may not compete. Monorchid or cryptorchid adult cats may not compete.
17. No exhibit may be removed from the hall before 5.00pm (except by PRIOR ARRANGEMENT with the Show Manager: early passes to leave will be granted only in exceptional circumstances).
18. A cat's status remains as at the closing date for entries to the Show. No alteration (e.g. Ch. or Pr.) may be added after this date.
19. No cats or kittens who do not appear as entries in the catalogue will be admitted to the Show Hall.

20. Any cat or kitten which, in the opinion of the judge, is very under-developed or in very poor condition shall be disqualified from competition. Any cat or kitten disqualified by a judge on grounds of condition must be reported by the Show Manager to the Cat Care Committee of the GCCF. For the guidance of novice exhibitors a kitten aged four months should weigh approx. 3-4lbs. depending on the Breed.
21. Minimum age for entry is 14 weeks. No cat born after Saturday, 26th August 2017 will be accepted.
22. ALL CATS, including household pets, must have a current vaccination certificate against Feline Infectious Enteritis, FVR + FVC (Cat 'Flu). **THE FULL COURSE IN ACCORDANCE WITH MANUFACTURERS INSTRUCTIONS must have been completed more than 7 days before the Show. Vaccination certificates, issued by a Veterinary Practice/Hospital, dated and signed by a Registered Veterinary Practitioner, clearly identifying both the exhibit and the owner, should be available for vetting in to avoid difficulties (see GCCF veterinary certificate rules). Homeopathic "Vaccination" is not adequate to meet this rule.**
23. Cats showing a positive reaction to either the Feline Leukaemia Virus or Feline Immunodeficiency Virus blood tests must not be shown.
24. Entries are limited and will be accepted in order of receipt.
25. Correspondence must be accompanied by a S.A.E. if a reply is desired; **WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND YOU ENCLOSE A STAMPED ADDRESSED POSTCARD FOR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RECEIPT OF YOUR ENTRY. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD ENTRIES BE SENT BY RECORDED DELIVERY. THIS WILL CERTAINLY CAUSE DELAY AND IS LIKELY TO LEAD TO ENTRIES BEING DECLINED.**
26. **THE TIPS OF EXHIBITS CLAWS MUST BE CLIPPED PRIOR TO THE SHOW.**
27. Any complaint must be received in writing by the Show Manager within 7 days of the Show.
28. Cheques that bounce cause unending extra work and cost us money in bank charges. A charge of £35.00 will be made for dealing with these.

**NO ENTRY MAY BE WITHDRAWN AFTER THE CLOSING DATE.**

SHOULD YOU BELIEVE THAT YOUR CAT MAY NEED A COUNTERSIGNATURE BECAUSE OF A JUDGE CHANGE AT THIS OR ANOTHER SHOW (CHECK YOUR SHOW RULES CONCERNING ELIGIBILITY FOR THIS) PLEASE ADVISE THE SHOW MANAGERS ABOUT IT **BEFORE JUDGING STARTS OR PREFERABLY BEFORE THE SHOW.**

**DEFINITION OF CLASSES**

BREED	Open to all untitled Cats or Neuters of the specific breed. Must be GCCF Registered.
OLYMPIAN	For full Imperial Grand Champions and Imperial Grand Premiers only.
IMPERIAL	For full Grand Champions and Grand Premiers only
GRAND	For full Champions and Premiers only
CATS	Not less than 9 calendar months on the day of the Show.
KITTENS	Not less than 14 Weeks and under 9 calendar months on the day of the Show. From 1st June 2001 Council have agreed that neuter kittens will be entered in Kitten Open and miscellaneous classes and will compete for BIS Kitten. Neuter kittens of preliminary breeds will be included in kitten assessment classes where separate class for Adult, Kitten and Neuter are scheduled. Please remember to inform the Show Managers if your kitten is neutered after you send in your entry.
NEUTER ADULTS	Neuter adults may only enter neuter classes and may not compete with entire cats or kittens except in Club Classes which are scheduled to include neuters. Where Best in Show is held, the best Neuter shall be considered against the Best Entire Adult and Kitten for Best Exhibit in Show.
GRCH & GR PR	The title of Grand Champion (or Grand Premier for neuters) shall be granted to an exhibit winning 3 Grand Champion (or Grand Premier) Certificates under 3 separate Judges.
IGRCH/IGRPR	The title of Imperial Grand Champion or Imperial Grand Premier for neuters shall be granted to exhibits winning 5 Imperial Grand Champion Certificates or Imperial Grand Premier Certificates at 5 Shows under separate judges.

**BREED CLASSES.** Untitled cats (GCCF Registered), adult or neuter, should enter these classes for their specified breed where they will compete for Challenge or Premier Certificates.

**GRAND CLASSES.** Cats which have attained Champion or Premier status should enter these classes in the relevant section, where they will compete for Grand Champion or Grand Premier Status.

**IMPERIAL CLASSES.** Cats which have attained Grand Champion or Grand Premier Status should enter these classes in the relevant section where they will compete for Imperial Grand Champion or Imperial Grand Premier Certificates.

**OLYMPIAN CLASSES.** Cats which have attained Imperial Grand Champion or Imperial Grand Premier Status should enter these classes where they will compete for Olympian Certificates

**Titled Cats may not enter classes at a level below their status, but all may compete for the Best of Breed Award. For titled cats, as well as entering the number of the relevant Grand/Imperial or Olympian class, PLEASE ENTER ALSO THE NUMBER OF THEIR RELEVANT BREED CLASS IN THE BREED CLASS BOX, AND TICK THE BOX FOR BOB ONLY.**

**Notes:**

- (1) To be eligible for entry into Olympian, Imperial or Grand Classes, the status of Imperial, Grand or Champion/Premier must have been attained on or before the closing date for entries to this Show, namely 5th December 2016
- (2) When counting wins/prizes, include all awarded in any class at a show held under GCCF rules.
- (3) Similarly, entry into restricted classes (Maiden/Limit etc) must be based on the exhibit's status on 5th December 2016
- (4) Wins as a Kitten do not count when the exhibit is shown as an Adult or a Neuter. Wins as an Adult do not count when the exhibit is shown subsequently as a Neuter.

**CLUB CLASSES** To enter a Club Class the exhibitor must be a member of the relevant club and Club Specials are only for fully paid-up members.

**HOUSEHOLD PETS:**

**NON PEDIGREE** Non-Pedigree Household Pets over 6 months of age on Show day must be neutered.

**PEDIGREE** Pedigree Household Pets: for Cats, Pedigree in appearance, with full or half pedigree back grounds, known or unknown.

All awards are given out with the understanding that in the event of a disqualification the awards must be returned on demand to the Show Manager by the recipient. Failure to comply with such a demand renders the exhibitor liable to disciplinary action by the GCCF.

**GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ENTERING SHOW**

Read the GCCF Rules first, available from the Kings Castle Business Park, The Drove, Bridgewater, Somerset TA6 4AG, or the Show Managers, Price £2.50 . Ask for advice if you are unsure about anything.

Print your entry form clearly

Complete your form from the GCCF Registration document, NOT from your pedigree.

Remember that errors may result in the withdrawal of certificates or prizes by the GCCF. If you see an error in your cat's description in the catalogue, tell the Show Manager immediately.

Details on what to expect from the GCCF in case of such errors are available from the GCCF or the Show Manager.

Remember that registration or transfer forms must have been received by the GCCF offices not less than 21 days before the Show.

If you have not received your registration/transfer document from the GCCF when you send your entry, put in the information you know is correct and RAF or TAF (Registration or Transfer Applied For) in the GCCF registration number box and send the full details once received to the Show Managers IMMEDIATELY

Remember that all registered owners must sign an entry form, and that forms from owners who are children will need an adult's signature.

Note that the exhibitor is the registered owner of the cat and not necessarily the person who actually takes the cat to the Show.

The breeder of a cat is always the registered owner of the Dam on the date of the cat's birth.

If you neuter your Cat or Kitten after sending your entry PLEASE TELL US.

Cats registered on the Reference Register may not be shown in competition.

Exhibitors of Household pets should enter details known to them. Vaccination and health rules apply but registration numbers will not be available and may be ignored

**Veterinary Clearance Certificates**

Exhibitors whose cats have been rejected at Shows please note the following points:

1. PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE THE VETTING IN AREA / SHOW HALL WITHOUT COLLECTING THE APPROPRIATE PAPERWORK (OFFICIAL REJECTION FORMS) FROM THE DUTY VETERINARY SURGEON. THIS WILL SAVE YOU A GREAT DEAL OF EFFORT LATER. IF YOU ARE IN ANY DOUBT ABOUT THIS PLEASE CONSULT THE SHOW MANAGER
2. When sending your Vet's Clearance Certificate to the GCCF Offices, please include your copy of the rejection form referred to in 1. above.
3. Please DO NOT send these certificates by special delivery post as it can cause delay in the receipt of your GCCF Clearance documents
4. Exhibitors should not attend Shows until they have received a letter from the GCCF office accepting and confirming clearance. It is recommended that this letter be taken to Shows within a month following its issue.

Please note that any person whose cats have been rejected under Sections C or D must not officiate as a judge or steward or in any capacity which requires the handling of cats at shows until a clearance certificate, as required by the GCCF, has been obtained.
